I have enclosed an attachment showing my latest descendant chart for Richard Whitlock, I have worked out that he was the ancestor of the Thomas Whitlock who married Martha White as per my last message.

I am certain I have the correct Thomas the only other possible was Thomas bpt 25 May 1743, I think he would have been rather old to marry Martha, also what clinched it for me was when I found the burials of a Thomas and Martha within a year of each other, when the birth date was calculated for Thomas, from his age at burial, it was 1752 ,he was bpt in 1751.

Have also decided the Robert who married Hannah Yeats was the one bpt 18 May 1711, son of James. The Robert bpt 4 Feb 1710/11 son of Robert, was buried 7 Feb 1710/11, son of Robert.

Would appreciate your comments please.

On reflection I am in agreement with Jennifer Spence, that the correct Joseph, father of Esau is the one bpt 29 July 1703.

Hi Peter,

Hope I am not a nuisance, but have made another link that will be of interest.

Have a will for a John Whitlock of Pitton, proved 27 Nov. 1816.

"This is my last will of me John Whitlock of Pitton labourer County of Wilts September 16 1808 first I give this house at Pitton to my son Stephen and that at Coldharbour to my dater (sic) Sarey and I give all my goods Stephen and Sarey my dater and every thing that is min (sic) to be equal (sic) be dived (sic) between them to (sic)."

>From the Pitton burial records John was 84y when he died in 1816 gives birth year of 1732. Baptism 13 Dec 1733 John son of Henry and Susannah Whitlock.

>From Pitton P. R's.

bpt. 20 Apr. 1777, Sara, dau John & Phoebe Whitlock at Pitton, born 17 Apr. 1777

Bpt 1 Oct 1780, Stephen, son John & Phoebe Whitlock at Pitton, born 26 Sept 1780.

I do hope this is new to you, I will post you a copy of John's will.

Since yesterdays e-mail found among my transcripts of Winterslow P. R's.,

Bpt. 6 Nov. 1768, Mary dau Thomas & Martha Whitlock.

This would appear to be another child born and bpt. in another Parish, before they married!

Did I send you a copy of the Whitlock entries in the Winterslow P. R's.?

Hi Peter,

Here I am again, been looking at the Pitton Monumental
Inscriptions, specifically the one for:-

Joseph Whitlock died 14 April, 1741, aged 54 (b. circa 1687)
Martha " his wife died 18 Nov.1769, aged 66 (b. circa 1703)
Mary " their dau. died 4 June 1747 aged 26 (b. circa 1721,
bpt 21 Jan 1725/26, date of burial appears incorrect only Mary
buried 4 June was Mary Whitlock jnr. in 1739 of Farley, perhaps
she was added to the gravestone when Martha's was buried, and
error made in date for Mary, other Mary's nearest to above date
were Mary 21 Aug. 1745, Mary 14 may 1749)

If these dates have been correctly copied from the gravestone, then
it would mean Joseph was born much earlier than we thought, and
it would explain the large gap between the bapt's of George
Whitlock's two children. It seems probable that for some reason he
was not baptized near his birth date, and only in 1703, and would
add more support to Jennifer Spencer's first hypothesis.

What do you think please?
