WOW. Thanks, I don't have any information going back that far. Most of my family information is from my grandmothers side, Anne Inches who married Colin Campbell Whitlock. They had three daughters, Muriel, Bessie, and Helen; and one son, Julius Lawton Whitlock. Muriel never married, Bessie married late in life, Julius married a couple of times, and the only Whitlock that had a child was my mother Helen. I have three sons, Mark, (married no children), Brian two daughters, Anna and Sarah 6&5, and Lance, one 3 yr old son, Peyton.

I do have an old bible that has this hand written inscription. As noted some of this is difficult to read as I indicated.

"Charlotte Whitlock, the daughter of Thomas & Ann Whitlock was born in the year of our Lord 1771, the 9th day of September at half past nine o clock in the morning. William Whitlock, the son of Thomas & Ann Whitlock was married to Jane Haslett (??), the daughter of Samuel and Elizabeth Haslett, the 21st (??) day of February in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred and eighty-five, Paiss Town (??) New Brunswick. Edward Land, the son of Georg and Jamina (??) Land was married to Anna Whitlock the daughter of Thomas and Ann Whitlock, August 4th in the year of our Lord, one thousand 700 and eighty five."

Have you ever seen the Whitlock Lighthouse, in Calais.

WOW. Thanks for the e-mail. I do have some family background although none of it comes out of the Pennsylvania area, at least I didn't think so. I understood my family was of Scottish background, primarily from the NB and Calais Me area. My Grandfather Colin Campbell Whitlock was a prominent citizen of Calais and I believe was Mayor at one time. About 10 miles down river from Calais is the Whitlock Mill Lighthouse, named for land where my grandfather had a mill. You can view this on the Calais web site. It is currently owned by the St. Croix Historical Society and embellishes the stationary of the Chamber of Commerce and the society's letterhead. During the time it was active it was listed on the maritime charts as "Lighthouse #1 in America."

I plan a vacation to Calais, St. Stephen (where our family is interned), St Andrews, St. John, Halifax and Yarmouth the end of July and early August. This will be my first time in the area in over 30 years.
