Hello Peter...

About time I got back to you. :) I FINALLY found the death certificate for Robert John Whitlock. His wife, Susannah was the informant. He died on Oct. 5th, 1844 at No. 4 Palefield St./Nelson St, in the sub-district of St. George, Camberwell, Co. of Surrey. He was 56 years of age, which means he was born in 1788. He was a gardener, and he died of an aneursym. Soo, I'm not sure what to make of this...this Robert is or is not the same Robert baptized in 1796? Note: all my Whitlocks have connections to St. Georges, none to St. Giles as of yet. He could have been baptized as a young boy?

Or, could be 2 different Roberts - I found a death entry on FreeBMD, a Robert Melvin Whitlock who died in Camberwell in March Qtr 1843.

Melanie Drolsbaugh: Thanks very much for the email - my apologies for the tardy reply. You ask if you fit in someone's family tree? Maybe... I do not have a marriage for a Robert John Whitlock and Susanna Green but I do have a Robert John Whitlock of Camberwell. I suspect he was the Robert Whitlock baptized at St.Giles Camberwell Aug.17,1796. He married Anne Parker about 1818-1819. They had children Henry 1820, Ann 1825, Mary Anne 1827 and William 1830. I assume this is the Robert Whitlock who is a witness at the marriage of Francis White and Fanny Bowles at St.George's, Camberwell Sep.22,1839.

Mary Anne Whitlock b.1827 married David Bunwood Green 1850 Southwark, Surrey so there is a Green connection as well. There is a marriage of a Robert Whitlock in 1839 but it is in Greenwich, Kent so if Robert John Whitlock married twice this could be the second marriage. Otherwise he could have married Susanna Green prior to 1837 which would not show in the St.Catherine's House Records. All speculation at this time.

Jack Brown descends from Mary Anne (Whitlock) (Green) Bigwood so I will send him a copy of this message. You show David William Whitlock born Jun.9,1841 at Neate Street, Camberwell the son of Robert John Whitlock and Susanna Green. David William Whitlock married Elizabeth Ann Marsh at Camberwell in 1863 so there is a definite Camberwell connection. "Robert John Whitlock" is an unusual name as not many people had two names in the 1700's who I would be surprised if there were two, both living in Camberwell.
