Dr. Walter "Bill" M. Whitlock, 75, of Chenango Bridge, NY, died Sunday, July 7 at Wilson Hospital. He was predeceased by his parents, Walter and Hyacinth Whitlock. In addition to his wife of 54 years, Mary E. Lenze Whitlock, of Chenango Bridge, he is survived by a son, Michael J. Whitlock of Cortland; daughter and son-in-law, Jacqueline and Stephen Lubniewski of Endicott; six grandchildren, Jessica, Cassandra and Christopher Whitlock of Cortland, and Jacelyn, Kaitlyn and Stephanie Lubniewski of Endicott. Mr. Whitlock was a graduate of Johnsonburg High School, Indiana University of Pennsylvania and Pennsylvania State University, where he received his masters and doctorate.
