Do you have any information please for a Mark R. Whitlock born 1841 in Eynsford Kent? My information comes from the 1881 Census where he was living in St. Pancras London, and his occupation was shown as provision merchant. His wife was Ann F. Whitlock b 1844 in Greenwich, Kent.

It would be very much of a coincidence if Mark was linked to the Pitton families, but one never knows.

Thank you for the interesting information, have downloaded WHITLOCK 20 CHART, and found the link to Jenny's family.

We have traced her TINKER family back to 1603 in Coninsbrough West Riding of Yorkshire. Her link to the Whitlock family is through her Great Aunt, Elizabeth Tinker born in Sheffield 29 May 1828, she married James Slater 1851, marriage registered in Sheffield R.D., first quarter, Vol. 9c, Page 364.

Their son Walter BRINDLEY Slater was b. 1860, St. Brides, London, calculated from the 1881 Census.

Walter married Lilian Frances Whitlock 1888, marriage registered in Islington R.D., third quarter, Vol. 1b, Page 611.

Beryl Lilian Slater was born 1889, in London, birth registered in Edmonton R.D., second quarter, Vol. 3a, Page 278.

Please note some of this information differs from the Whitlock 20 Chart, I am sure I have the correct information, have given source.
