While doing some looking for more on our Whitlock family I ran across a bit of information that I need your help on. Here is what I found;

In the Family Tree Maker disk for the Colonial Virginia Source Records, 1600-1700's Abstracts form 18th-Century Virginia Newspapers, Surnames W-X, Page 365.

It has on it this:

Whitlock, Josiah, Sr. late of Pr. Edw. Co., dec'd, e.a.w. his ex; Geo. Moore and Thos. Flournoy (VGR 30 Aug 70), [I take this to mean 1770 that he died.

Who is this one ?

The other one that I have on the same page is this one:

Whitlock, William , of Caroline Co; des'd, pursuant to his will, a tract of his land on Polecat Swamp containing by estimation 200 ac. two dwelling houses, and a good apple and peach orchard will be sold by Wm. Whitlock (nfi) (VG 4 Dec 78)- then it goes on to say:

Whitlock, William, Clerk of Petersburg District Ct; died (VGPI 10 Oct 97)

Could this be the father to our William and also his father's father and grandfather all in the same area?

Our William Whitlock that was born in 1787 and married Elizabeth [Green] , would be about the right age to be a son of one of these person. Can you help me on this or do you know if these men fit into our families? Anything that you can tell me about will help.

Thank you for any help that you can give and as to the other that you asked me about I am sorry but I have not found anything either on them.
