Dear Peter

I apologize for my excessive delay in responding. We are "knee deep" in Christmas planning, buying & wrapping but I did want to get back with you and also assure you that I am very interested in following up with the Whitlock's, Smith's, etc. Once Xmas is over I may just copy and send you some of my notes, info all in draft form to provide you with some of my information.

First, I'll give you whatever dates I have from the main line that you sent to me. (. James Whitlock was born circa 1740. However according to my information he was the one child of James Whitlock II and Agnes Christmas. This James was born ca 1718 and died in 1749. Agnes was born ca 1715 , died 1768. Most likely they lived in the Henrico Co, or Hanover Co. VA area. Agnes was born in VA Approx. 1715.

James Whitlock II was the son of James Whitlock and Frances Jones.

Sarah A. Whitlock was born ca 1841, died prior to 1920. Sarah married Robert Grove in 1858, Nov. 6.

Flora Grove was born was born Dec. 9, 1863 . She died in 23 Apr, 1927 in Cane Valley Adair Co, Ky. My uncles all lived in this area and apparently there is a Whitlock family cemetery nearby in Christian Co., Ky.

Nancy Perry was born ca 1838 and remarried after Manoah passed away. Louard Smith, my grandfather was born Apr 10, 1889 in Cane Valley, Adair Co., Ky. He died in 1966. My father Louis Smith, Sr. was born April 9, 1921 and my mother Dorothy was born March 4, 1928 and died in 1992.

Peter at this point this is all of the information that I can retrieve from my rather disjointed stack of documents. I did read that apparently the Whitlocks of VA and the Radfords of VA who was the maternal side of William Whitlock of Ky were fairly prominent in VA and did a lot of "in-breeding" for lack of a better word. I have information on the Radford's. William Whitlock's maternal side back to the Maxeys who were Huegenots that fled France after the Edict of Nantz.

In any event I would like to get with you with a great deal more of this information and may try to copy much of it and send it to you after the holidays.
