I was browsing thru the Washington Post web-site the other day and came across a list of all the American soldiers killed in Iraq. There was a Garrison on the list - Sgt.

Landis W Garrison from Rapids City, Illinois. He was in the 333rd Military Police in the Illinois National Guard and he was only 23, I think. He died of gunshot wounds in that prison we heard so much about earlier this year. It was rather odd. It wasn't clear what happened. <Clip>

I didn't get all this from the Washington Post but from various Illinois papers. Anyway the boy's father was named Randy. (Incidentally there was a Vanda Landis -born 1900, died 1937- who was the daughter of Creed and Theora Garrison Whitlock. Ring any bells? Dad used to talk about a cousin Creed)
