Thank you for your prompt reply. My father's family lived in Dagenham before they moved to Romford. My memory of his brothers is that they were named Ted, David, Fred, and Tommy, his sisters were Florence and Marie. I think the family originally lived in London and were rehoused in Dagenham. Before the war Dad and his brother Tommy worked for an engineering firm called Teleflex. Dad also played the piano accordion in a small band. During the war he was in the airforce, and I believe that he spent two years in Berlin at the end of the war. When he returned he, Tommy, and his sister Florence, worked for Romford Council. Dad was a manager on the Cleansing Department until he retired, and Florence worked for the Parks Department. She was married and I am afraid I do not know her married name. Uncle Ted had his own engineering firm. Dad rarely talks about his family as there seems to have been a rift that neither of my parents will talk about.
