Her name is listed as various spellings Georgia Ann, Georgeann, Georgann. She is thier daughter. I have attached an old family picture which appeared in the newspaper The Mena Star in which she stands to the right (looking at the picture) behind Manerva. I grew up in Mena, Polk County and had a lot of Ellison cousins, some of whom I didn't realize were related to me, but my mother and father knew. My father, Guy Parker, was the son of Georgeann Ellison and David Green Parker. The Ellisons and Parkers belonged to the Primitive Baptist church at Board Camp, Polk, Arkansas, adjacent to the cemetery. One of Jonathan's sons was said to be the preacher there for many years. Georgeann and Manella Ellison were sisters who married Parker brothers. So there is a lot of history intertwined.

I wish I had been interested in asking questions when my parents and grandparents were alive. My mother's sister, Grace Sims Riales, making her daughter my cousin both through the Sims line and the Ellison.

Thank you for the web site. I will be visiting it when I can.

Thank you for the updated chart. I am still working on the Ellisons from the updates you sent. As you may know, Jonathan G. was patriarch of a very large clan. I've had some other obligations, but am plodding away at it.

I have attached the information about my mother's (Thelma Sims) sister, Grace, who was married to Lessie L. Riales. I don't know how much you want to know, but just in case, here is the information about her parents.

Her father was Jasper Hudson Sims, b. Mar 1851, Arkansas, d. 12 Jul 1931, Mena Arkansas and Frances Rodella Martin, b. 1872 in Arkansas, d. 29 Apr 1940, Mena Arkansas.

Jasper was the son of Thomas Bentley Sims, b. 03 Apr 1817, South Carolina, d. 13 Jul 1881 Malvern, Hot Spring, Arkansas and Catherine Adeline Mayfield, b. 04 Jan 1828, Alabama, d. 13 Mar 1913 Malvern, Hot Spring, Arkansas.

I didn't print all of his data, only the information about Grace whose moter was Frances Rodella (Della) Martin, otherwise it would have been very long and probably not relevant to what you want.

Frances Rodella was the daughter of John Martin, b. 08 Apr 1826, Macon, Georgia, d. 03 Jan 1879, Saline County, Arkansas and Olive Ann Fowler b. 11 Jun 1836, Macon, Georgia, d. (date unknown) Saline County, Arkansas. We believe both parents died before Frances Della was old enough to be her own. I have a picture of the aunt and uncle who raised her. No names with the picture, unfortunately.

This probably is much more than you wanted to know about Grace's family. You will note that her grandchildren's information is not complete. My main contact is with the younger grandson, Billy Chesshir who is a bivocational minister, also works as a junior high school counselor in Hot Springs, but I will eventually print a copy of the Sims report and send to him asking him to get with his siblings to get their and their children's information.

Lessie Riales was my father's, Guy Parker's (son of Georgia Ann Ellison) cousin, and Grace was my mother's (Thelma Sims) sister; therefore we are connected on two sides.
