I believe that I have found a small piece of additional information for the Connecticut Whitlock line "The Whitlocks of Cholesbury, Buchinghamshire England & Conneticut, U,S,A, #"

With the help of several other researchers, we think we have found the wife of Zalmon Whitlock (1795-1852) who shows up as "M2" in this descendency chart. I believe that his wife is Sarah/Sally Gorham (b. Jan 1798 Redding, Connecticut d. 1859 Northfield, Connecticut) her parents are Jabez Gorham (b. 1762 Fairfield Ct d. 1853 Redding Connecticut) and Hannah Beers (b. 1769 d.???)

Dear Peter(s),

There is both a long answer and a short answer to the question of documentation for our Sarah/Sally (Gorham) Whitlock. The long answer--the e-mail correspondence with Art Cole who had the answer to this puzzle--is attached. The short answer is that with the information that Sarah/Sally Gorham (1798-1859) is the person in question, it is possible to look for confirming information. Our Sarah/Sally is apparently a very shy person and the only source that came up on ancestry.com is the following:

"The Whitney family of Connecticut and its affiliations: being an attempt to trace the descendants as well in the female...." Vol. II part 1 Eight Generation pg 1262 entry #8300

The following is the entry for the second child of Russell and Mary Jane (Culver) Osborn:

"II.Emma Culver Osborn, b. in New York City 16 Sept. 1834;married there, 13 May 1851, Charles Whitlock, a broker in real estate born at Plymouth, Conn Sept 1826, son of Zalmon and Sarah (Gorham) Whitlock. There were living at 1160 Warren Street, Brooklyn, N.Y in Nov.1873"

I would love to find more documentation, but for the moment I'm not sure where else I can look from my location in southern Oregon. Hope that the "long" and "short" answers help!
