Thank you, so much, for the wonderful response. My sister, Sara, is the one doing our research, so I have forwarded everything along to her. I think the connection you suggest makes sense. I do recall that my father was contacted years back by someone who wanted our family to join a suit against the city of Baltimore because some land was (supposedly) not properly deeded over the city years and years ago. Since he wanted a retainer up front, my father didn't choose to participate! My great-grandfather, Thomas Sidney Whitelock, was a Seventh-Day Adventist minister and doctor, who was sent by Ellen G. White herself to San Diego at the turn of the 20th century to found a sanitarium. He did so, and it is now a hospital in National City - the first in San Diego. He passed the medical practice down to his son, Thomas Sidney Whitelock II, who passed it down to my dad, Thomas Sidney Whitelock III. So, this medical practice in San Diego was headed by a TSW for a hundred years. Interestingly enough, I do recall going up to Paradise, CA to visit our two elderly "aunts," Pearl and Lulu. I'm not sure what their exact relationship was to us, but there is a Pearl and Lulu who are daughters of Theodore and Mary Whitelock (below). I'm sure we'll be in touch!
