A strong believer in the important function a library plays to public literacy and education, Mary Carolyn was a board member and active volunteer with the Friends of the Winter Haven Library. Mary Carolyn was a past president of the Valhalla Homeowners Association and was a member and volunteer at St. Paul's Episcopal Church. In addition, she was a loyal supporter of the arts, especially the Ridge Art Association and Theatre Winter Haven. Her active community involvement instilled in her the kindness, compassion and unselfishness for which she is widely known.

More than anything else, Mary Carolyn took obvious joy in spending time with her friends and family, particularly her four grandchildren. Her fondest memories were of vacations at Little Gasparilla Island and she took great pleasure in reviewing the years of logbooks that chronicled everyone's adventures there.
