In the presence of a congregation that almost filled the auditorium, funeral services were conducted in the First Baptist Church, Tahoka, for Mrs. W. B. Edwards, 64. Mrs. Edwards died in the Lubbock Memorial Hospital at 1 A.M., Friday, Feb. 22, 1946 from a heart attack. Services were conducted by Rev. C. J.
