Woman injured in car smash

A woman was injured in a head-on collision in Chloride Street on Saturday night. She is Mrs Elizabeth Jean Whitlock of Thomas Street, a passenger in a car driven by her husband, Frederick Whitlock.

Mrs Whitlock is in a satisfactory condition in hospital.

She has five broken ribs, a broken collarbone and lacerations.

Her husband escaped injury.

The driver of the other car, Donald Alexander McInnes, of Blende Street, also escaped injury.

The impact of the collision forced one of the vehicles into a third car driven by Graham Barry Trappell, of Melbourne.

The accident happened at 10.20 pm near the Beryl Street intersection.

A new Valiant car being carried on a truck was wrecked when the truck overturned on the Wilcannia Road at 5 pm yesterday.

The driver of the truck, Brian Barnett, escaped injury.

The truck was also carrying a quantity of motor vehicle spare parts.
