"What memories photographs bring back", says T. E. Oliver, old timer of Wawota. Last week Mr. Oliver saw the picture on the front page, of George Whiting shaking hands with Jim McGuirl. This reminds me, says Mr. Oliver, "when the same Mr. James McGuirl happened along at the farm home of T. E. Oliver (and the late Mrs. Oliver who passed away in 1956), in the Glen Adelaide district in 1897, and took a photograph of their baby, about six months old. The baby is now E. Norman Oliver, postmaster at Wawota, and the photograph still hangs on the wall of Mr. Oliver's home in New Westminster, not even faded. Mr. Oliver, who lives at 1826 8th Avenue, New Westminster, celebrated his 88th birthday on December 24th. The late Mrs. Oliver was the daughter of Fred Whitlock, one of the pioneers of Glen Adelaide, six miles south of Wawota.
