# Eldorado man dies in crash

An Eldorado man was killed in an accident last night on Ill. 13, about one mile east of Rt. 1.

Dan James, 46, was a passenger in a 1977 Dodge, driven by Willard Parkinson, 58, of Harrisburg.

Their car collided with a 1977 Cadillac, driven by Price Brown Jr., 28, of Mount Vernon, Ind. According to the accident report, Brown was eastbound on 13, while Parkinson was westbound. Parkinson's vehicle crossed the center line and struck Brown's car head-on.

Parkinson and Brown received major injuries. Parkinson was taken to Ferrell Hospital, then transferred to Welborn Hospital in Evansville, where he was listed in serious condition this morning. Brown was taken directly to Welborn, and was listed in fair condition this morning.

No arrests have been made in the accident, police say, pending further investigation.

Dan James, 46, of 2121 North Illinois Ave., Eldorado was dead on arrival at 12 midnight at Ferrell Hospital, Eldorado following an auto accident on Rt. 13, one mile east of Rt. 1.

He was born on March 16, 1938 in Raleigh, son of the late Howard James and Georgia Whitlock James. He was a member of the Eldorado First Baptist Church.

Survivors include his wife, the former Nan Hicks; a son, Stephen James, Carbondale; his mother, Mrs. Georgia James, Raleigh; a granddaughter, Miranda Kay James of Carbondale; a brother, Dennis James and a sister, Mrs. Chuck (Ona) Maloney of Eldorado.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday at Bean Colonial Terrace in Eldorado, where friends may call from 6 to 9 p.m. Wednesday. The Rev. Alan Redfern will officiate and burial will be in Raleigh Masonic Cemetery.
