## N. Whitlock, Ex-C-E Ad Exec. Dies

Norris C. Whitlock, 80, who retired from The Courier-Express in 1962 as an executive in national advertising, died Saturday (Dec. 31, 1977) in Kenmore Mercy Hospital. He lived in St. Lawrence Avenue.

His 25-years of service with The Courier-Express highlighted a career in newspapering which began with a reportorial stint with the Daily News in Batavia.

### Warsaw Native

A native of Warsaw, he attended high school in Batavia. Later he served as a general assignment reporter in Meadville, Pa. He was employed in the same capacity with the old Buffalo Times and the Buffalo Evening News before joining the advertising staff at The Courier-Express.

While at the Courier-Express he was secretary of the Food Industry Sales Executives.

### Survivors

Besides his wife, the former Muriel Donnelly, he is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Jack Merlino of Derby, and a son, Norris H. Whitlock of Charleston, S.C.

Services will be at 10 a.m. Tuesday in the Central Park United Methodist Church, 216 Beard Ave. Interment will be in Warsaw Cemetery, Warsaw.
