The Whitlocks were originally members of the Church of England.

There is a Rev. Estlin Whitlock buried in Langtree Church Yard at the
 Parish Church. At the time of John Wesley they all joined the
 Bible Christian denomination. My grand father, George Whitlock gave a
 piece of his farm, "Callacott," Langtree, on which the Bible Christian Chapel,
 "Siloam" was built. Adjoining it is a graveyard in which several
 Whitlocks are buried. I am sad to say that Siloam has recently
 been closed. John Whitlock, who married Catherine Palmer, and my
 father, John P. A. Whitlock, were both Bible Christian Local Preachers.

Wilfred Whitlock, of Vancouver, has particulars of the Whitlocks who
 went to Prince Edward Island in 1830.
