John Whitehead (father of Jack, Matilda & Fred) has been
 looking George & Jane. All three were born, John the youngest
 at Fifeburg, England, in an apartment with the name
 Avenue de l'Industrie and Telford. There are no other exact
 street of Middleburgh. The name is unclear as to where there
 is some connection apparently with the family John
 Whitehead married into. probably a village name often on day
 for family.

I wonder if this could have any connection with your own
 family. In the title of the Whitehead a pair of men, and to be
 brought out to note in a copy of newspaper clipping of the address
 exact by least distance of a Mrs Whitehead of no. 146. Platt
 St. London, which was a Mrs. to William, who lives
 in London St. I don't think this spelling - minus the E - is a
 typographical error as it is repeated three times. The Whitehead
 family has as yet think who was their grandmother, none of
 them think she ever lived in London. Although there are no
 data on this item, under another heading is Oct. 1st, 1900 year,
 but I think it must be 1900-1910.
