My father wrote that <sup>A</sup> three sisters and four brothers. The three sisters--Laura, Fannie, and Clara--were all "spinsters." (On your print-out you indicate a fourth sister--Mary WHITLOCK--but my father doesn't mention her.) In 1913, my father accompanied his Aunt Fanny and his Aunt Laura to Winnepeg, where they joined their brother Walter. The two women ran a boarding house, and my father lived with them until he went to France with the Canadian Expeditionary Force\* to fight the Germans in WWI. My father's Uncle Harry emigrated to Queensland, Australia, where he became a sheep farmer. I am occasionally in touch with one of his granddaughters, Lorna Driver (married to Eric Driver; address: 14 Hilgay St., Coolaroo 3048, Victoria, Australia), who has four sons. Her mother was, I believe, Harry's daughter; her name was Violet. My father's Uncle Will also emigrated to Canada, homesteaded in Souris, Manitoba (Sovris?). Only one brother remained in England, my father's Uncle Charles, a businessman; he had a son named Derek.

\* My father wrote: "In December 1915 Jim [his cousin and his Uncle Walter's son] and I enlisted in 3rd Div. Canadian Field Artillery--went to Eng. Mar. 1916 & to France in June--became Staff Sgt.--was discharged in W'peg 4/1/1919. ... Took job with oil co.--later transferred to Regina, Sask. as credit manager. Left there in 1923 for coast on account of long winters. Ended up in Seattle. Got job with Union Oil Co. for whom I worked 35 yrs retiring in Oct 1958." NWVA-16
