- € 1622, 6 Jun The old John Whitlocke of Kersell, buried
- € 1630, 24 Jun Jane the wife of William Whitlocke buried
- € 1630, 2 Nov John Whetloke of Cerscoll buried

EXETER MARRIAGE LICENCES

1732, 25 Aug John Jolliffe, of Bradworthy, yeoman, & Mary Whitlock, of Wooltery, widow

WILLS etc. proved in the Court of Principal Registry, Exeter [P.R. Exon]

- 1646 Admors Anthony Whitlock [West] Woolfardisworthy (perhaps killed in Civil War)
- NE-1* 1731 Will <sup>d</sup> Elston Whitlocke, clerk, Langtree  
[he was the son of Eliz Elston by John Whitlocke of Warkleigh, \*Devon, gent., rector of Langtree 1705-1731, following his uncle, John Elston]

1711/2, 16 Feb William Orchard & Phillip Whitlock, of Stratton

[WEST] WOOLFARDISWORTHY

*E- NI-20* The P.C.C. Will, dated 1658 & proved at London (143 Pell) 1658/9, of Philip Praunce, yeoman of Woolfardisworthy, mentions "my sister Alice Whitlock".
