NOTICE TO POSTMASTER.

The dated stamp is to be placed on the other side against the month to which the payment relates as indicated in writing on the Money Order, e.g., in paying an Allotment for the month of September, the stamp is to be placed against September, at the top of the first column. BEFORE payment, it should be seen that the Naval Allotment Number on the face of this Document agrees with the Naval Allotment Number on the Money Order, and that the Certificate of Identity above has been completed.

"Advices" are not issued for Naval Allotment Money Orders.

NOTICE TO ALLOTTEE.

This Allotment is payable on the last working day of each month, or on any working day in the following month. It is particularly requested that Payment be applied for regularly every month, as, if this be not done, the Money Order is returned from the Post Office, and Payment cannot be obtained without delay or special application to the Admiralty. If, however, payment be not demanded on this Bill within six months of the date of its having been signed at the Admiralty, or from the date of the last payment hereon, it will become cancelled.

When the Allottee is unable in consequence of bodily infirmity to attend at the Post Office to receive payment, the Postmaster, on production of this Document by the Representative of the Allottee, will furnish the necessary Form of Sick Certificate provided on the back of the Money Order, to enable such Representative to obtain payment.

All Letters relating to Naval Allotments are to be addressed to the "ACCOUNTANT GENERAL OF THE NAVY, ADMIRALTY, LONDON, S.W.," with "A.G.—12" on the left corner, and should furnish the Allotment number, and name of last ship upon which the Allotter is known to be serving.

When a change in the place of payment is desired, this Document should be returned and the new address stated.

GENERAL NOTICE.

N.B.—By virtue of the Acts 28 and 29 Vict., cap. 124, the personating or falsely assuming the Name or Character of any Person to obtain Payment of an Allotment, or uttering a false Declaration or other false writing for the purpose of receiving an Allotment, is made punishable by Penal Servitude or Imprisonment.

This Document is valueless as a security for money advanced or payment of debts, and being the property of the Allottee must not be parted with unless required by the Admiralty, or difficulties will arise in the payment of the Allotment.
