I give to my cousin Samuel Whitlock the sum of 20 pounds. I give to my cousin Peter Whitlock the sum of 30 pounds. I give to my cousin Elias Whitlock the sum of 20 pounds. I give to my cousin Sally Whitlock the sum of 20 pounds. I give to my cousin Grace Ayre the sum of 20 pounds. I give to my cousin Betsy Western the sum of 20 pounds.- Thomazin first above after her decease. I give to cousin Mary Tricks two daughters Charlotte Whitlock & Mary Ann Tricks the sum of two pounds each when 21 years. Lastly all residue to Richard Whitlock- sole Executor 7 Dec. 1830
