the county of Somerset Farmer hereby revoke all former wills and testamentary disposi-
tions made by me and declare this to be my last will and testament I appoint my

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dear wife Mary Ann Whitlock and my son Harold and Richard Lawson Coad of 27 Old Jewry London Solicitor to be the EXECUTORS of this my will I give and devise my freehold estate known as West Down Farm situate at Nunney in the county of Somerset with the lands and appurtenances thereunto belonging including the piece of ground called Wall Close situated in the parish of Cloford unto and to the use of my dear wife her heirs and assigns I give to my son George Henry Methaway the sum of 2500 (five hundred pounds) and I give to each of my children John Allen Harold Eveline Henrietta and Dora Elizabeth the sum of four hundred pounds but I declare that none of the said pecuniary legacies shall be payable for a period of three years after my decease and in the case of any child who is under age at my decease unless and until such child shall attain the age of twenty one years and that in the meantime none of the said legacies shall bear interest but my executors may in their absolute discretion advance at any time the whole or any part of any of such legacies to any of my children I give all my property not hereby otherwise disposed of unto my dear wife absolutely And I declare it to be my wish that my son Harold shall remain with her and help her in carrying on my farming business And I declare that my executors may employ a Solicitor to act for them in any matters connected with the winding up of my affairs and the administration of my estate and that an executor or trustee of this my will being a Solicitor may charge and be paid his usual charges for work done in connection with such winding up or administration IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto set my hand to this my will the eleventh day of January 1913
