THE WILL OF WILLIAM SMALE - 1834

The following will is dated Nov.15,1834 and was proved Jan.19,1839. William Smale died Dec.11,1838. This will is a perfect example of a document from a collateral line that provides a huge amount of information. William Smale's niece Mary Smale married Richard Whitlock of Langtree May 10,1770. It appears William Smale was related to most of the major North Devon families!!! Certainly to the main Langtree ones.

This is the last Will and Testament of me William Smale of Frithelstock in the County of Devon, Yeoman.

I give and bequeath to the poor of the parish of Frithelstock aforesaid the Sum of Five pounds to be dispensed? within three months after my decease in such manner as my Executor and Executrix hereinafter named shall think proper.

I give and bequeath to the several persons hereinafter mentioned the following legacies that is to say to my Brother John Smale the sum of nineteen pounds. To my Nephew John Smale the younger son of my said Brother John Smale the sum of One hundred pounds. To my niece Rebecca Fursman Wife of John Fursman of Buckland Brewer in the said County Butcher the Sum of Sixty pounds. To each of the children of my said niece Rebecca Fursman (that is to say) John, Joseph, Susanna, Catharine, Rebecca, Harriet and Emily Fursman the sum of Five pounds.
