This Indenture made this eighth day of March in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred and seventy nine Between Thomas Whitlock of the County of Halifax of the one part and James Medley of Cumberland City of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Whitlock for and in consideration of the sum or One thousand three hundred Pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged Hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents Doth give grant bargain and sell to the said James Medley and to his Heirs and assigns forever one certain piece tract or parcel of Land containing three hundred and twenty four acres be the same more or less lying or being in the county of Halifax on the North side of Dan River and bounded as followeth beginning on the said river thence North twenty one degrees West fifty six poles to a white oak thence East two hundred and twenty poles to a white oak thence South along the said line Richard Edward's corner (formerly Robert's) in the Switzer branch thence along the said William Roberts or Edward's line to the mouth of the Switzer Branch then down the said Dan River with meanders to the beginning it being the Land and plantation wherein Thomas Whitlock now lives and the same that he bought of Haman Miller, together with all houses gardens orchards ways fences water and watercourses woods and underwoods and all the profits advantages and heristements thereunto belonging or appertaining thereto also the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders and all the other rights and titles and interests of him the said Thomas Whitlock and of his Heirs Executor, etc., forever TO HAVE AND TO HOLD possess and enjoy the above mentioned sold Lands and premises to the only proper use and behoof of the said James Medley and of his Heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas Whitlock doth hereby for himself and his Heirs covenant and agree to and with the said James Medley and his Heirs the above Lands and premises unto the said James Medley and his Heirs and and assigns forever against him the said Thomas Whitlock his heirs' Executors administrators and against all and every person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and by these presents forever defend In Witness Whereof the said Thomas Whitlock has hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year above written.

MEMORANDUM At a court held for Halifax County the 18th day of March 1779 This Indenture between Thomas Whitlock of the one part and James Medley of the other was by the said Thomas acknowledged to be his act and deed and the same was said to be recorded and Elizabeth the wife of the said Thomas who being first privately examined according to the Law did fully and voluntarily relinquish all rights of Dower in and to the said Land and premises conveyed by this Indenture.
