 I give fifty pounds to buy her a wedding gown and a new dress and to my dear and beloved
 and to her five pounds of lawful money of the said county of Middlesex and a quarter of a
 to the poor of the parish of St. Martin in the city of London to be distributed at the discretion of my executor
 about the time of the death of the said Robert and his heirs male and assigns and not about for other uses or
 otherwise shall be able to help themselves and I do hereby revoke all former wills made by
 me in this behalf and I have done so by my last will and testament published in presence of
 John Broom and Elizabeth Broom.

 after my just debts and funeral expenses being paid and discharged all my goods what-
 soever Bonds Bills debts due unto me and all other writings or writings whatsoever which
 my way doth or may come unto me together with full power to do the same whosoever
 the pleasure shalld be to her own discretion And I do hereby direct my above said wife to
 be my sole and whole executrix to this my last will and testament touching all other wills
 and power at any time heretofore granted to any other person whatsoever in this behalf
 which I have heretofore done by my last will and testament this day of August the thousand
 five hundred fifty and eight signed sealed and delivered in the presence of John Phillips
 and others.
